Practical examinations consist of 120 marks for Medicine, 120 marks for Surgery, 80 marks for OBGY and 40 for Paediatrics. The aggregate of all these three internal assessment examinations are taken as internal assessment marks and are reduced to the level of internal assessment marks (20%).

h) How has it influenced the result at the final examination:

It is essential to obtain 35% marks to be eligible to appear at Final Examination and Contributes 20% in the Final Examination marks.
