FRANCISAL EAST POINT COLLEGE OF MEMOCAL SCIENCES AND RESEARCH CENTRE, BANGALORE-560 049 percentage from 78% to 58% which makes a difference of 61 in-patients (i.e., 235-174 = 61).

In view of the gross difference of 61 in-patients it was felt that some pages could have gone missing inadvertently and all wards might not have been taken into account, the Principal requested the Assessors to recount the actual number of in-patients which were noted by the Assessors, in order to be certain of the numbers. However this request was not accepted.

Even though the in-patient number is taken wrongly as 174 by the Assessors, the bed occupancy works out to be 58% and a random 10% (18 patients) deduction from "174" inpatients results in 156 inpatients and it works out to be 52% of bed occupancy and not 48% as mentioned in the report. This calculation error may be ignored.

Despite repeated requests to relook into the number of in-patients as noted during the hospital rounds by the Assessors, they refused to show even the figures noted by them.

The following 8 (eight) in-patients who were

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not accepted by the Assessors were genuine and deserved admission for the reasons explained below.

- 1) Kusuma IP no 1811779 was admitted on 24.09.2018 with 14 weeks of gestation, previous LSCS and fetal megacystis with a plan for termination of pregnancy. Her pregnancy was terminated on 26.09.2018. This admission is genuine.
- 2) Geetha IP no 1811688 was admitted on 22.09.2018 with 34 weeks pregnancy, low back pain, leaking membranes with UTI. This patient deserved admission.
- 3) Ancy K Chako IP no 1811762 was admitted on 23.09.2018 with 39 weeks of pregnancy for symptoms of UTI. She is also known case Hypothyroidism on treatment.
- 4) Ganesh IP 1811680 was admitted on 22.09.2018 with pain abdomen initially diagnosed as Ac gastritis and subsequently found to have left renal calculus with left hydroureteronephrosis on imaging and needed admission for treatment.

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- 5) Janardhan IP no 1811650 was admitted on 22.09.2018 for pain in the right hypochondriac region of four weeks duration. Provisionally diagnosed as Acute Cholecystitis and improved on treatment.
- 6) Vajrappa IP no 1811641 was admitted on 22.09.2018 with history of abdominal pain, vomiting and haemetemesis. He was a chronic alcoholic. He was admitted for alcoholic gastritis, acute pancreatitis and suspected hollow viscous perforation.
- 7) Lalithamma, IP no 1811738, was admitted 23.09.2018 for pain in loin radiating to left groin with diagnosis of left renal colic?, renal calculus. This patient also had Pterygium for excision.
- 8) Sudhakar IP no 1811651 was admitted on 22.09.2018 a known case of acute pancreatitis. Readmitted for recurrence of symptoms namely pain abdomen and vomiting. The patient was managed conservatively.
