Sir,

With respect to the ongoing MCI inspection for starting a new medical college in General hospital campus at Trivandrum, Kerala, the following gross deficiencies are brought to your urgent attention, since the health department authorities of the govt are trying hard to defraud the MCI inspectors by cleverly covering up the deficiencies at the campus. The new medical college is being claimed as a major achievement by the government, with the assembly elections coming in April 2016. In reality no new development has happened in the GH campus yet and only the existing patient services are being curtailed to show for buildings for the new medical college.

Besides there is a danger of MCI inspectors colluding with the authorities by filing a factually dishonest inspection report to the MCI. It may also be noted that a case is pending with the Hon high court of Kerala in this regard, calling for extreme diligence in inspection and approval in the situation of grossly inadequate facilities for a new medical college at GH campus Thiruvananthapuram.

This type of dishonest inspection and false affidavits by the govt health dept have caused approval for Govt Medical colleges at Idukki and Manjeri, both of which are in miserable state with not even having basic minimum facilities for patient care or medical education. There are said to be no physicians or ophthalmologists or radiologists in these medical colleges.

The case of the new government medical college in Trivandrum is not very different. Even the GH campus is not big enough to accommodate 50 vehicles inside it.

The following deficiencies may be particularly looked into during inspection and in the inspection report to avert the tragedy that happened in Idukki and Manjeri.

- 1) Existing patient services and facilities are being encroached upon to find building space for the new medical college without any new construction. Surgical wards, store rooms, medical records library have been vacated to house the administrative block, class rooms, laboratory etc. This should be pointed out and held out as a disqualification.
- 2) The land area requirement for new medical colleges doesn't meet the MCI norms in districts with more than one medical colleges already. Thiruvananthapuram district already has 5 medical colleges around. The split-campus for this new medical college is also against MCI rules in terms of land requirement.
- 3) There is no land for sports ground, parking inside the hostel.
- 4) The hostel facilities that the authorities are showing are temporary houses used for the athletes during the national games in 2015, which are already due to be dismantled. They are not permitted permanent structures as per building rules.
- 5) There is currently no library, power laundry, central sterilization unit, laboratory surgical ICU, medical ICU etc in GH campus
- 6) The new construction for the new medical college is in early stages and will require at least 2 years for completion. There is now an effort to speedily complete a floor in the multi-storied construction without any approval from fire safety dept

or the corporation. This is to fool the MCI inspectors during the next visit due in a month from now. The inspectors may be specifically asked to verify regulatory clearance and completion certificates for new construction during their visit.

7) Hence it is requested that the MCI stringently assess each and every aspect of inspection report before giving approval as sub-standard govt medical colleges are coming up every where in Kerala only for the sake of political mileage. It is also requested in the interest of medical education in Kerala to stop giving permission liberally on the basis of false affidavits by the government so that shamefully inadequate govt medical colleges like Idukki and manjeri do not repeat in other parts of Kerala which already has more 35 medical colleges. Also new medical colleges should not be allowed to come up merely for political mileage for the government. A moratorium for new medical colleges is highly needed now for Kerala with its current tally of 35 medical colleges. This has resulted in all types of medical corruption.
