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		<p>the initial discussion with the Dean and Principal, it was 10.20 AM when we circulated the message to the faculties and residents to assemble before the Principal's office and sign in the attendance register before 11AM. In response to this with all the faculties including those taking classes in various departments, those who had gone to the sub centres, those who were involved in medical camps at distant places and those who had been on duty off after the night duties of the prior day had all reported in full strength within one hour of the message but the assessors counted only those who reported before 11 AM. On 06-05-2016 University practical examination of third MBBS part II (General Medicine, General Surgery, OBG and Paediatrics subjects) was ongoing and the faculties were engaged in examination process further cases were ongoing in operation theatre and lecture classes were being conducted by faculties and some of the faculties were in medical camps which were conducted at distant places by the community medicine department and those doctors availing duty off in the quarters after night duty could not report by 11.AM but everybody were present between 11 AM and 11.15 AM. Even among the doctors who had signed in the attendance register by 11.15 AM were not counted during the headcount citing certain entry mistakes in the declaration forms. For example Dr. Raman M.R, Senior Resident and Dr. V.K Gopi Asst. Prof of General Surgery department were rejected citing reasons mentioned as above. The list of faculties</p>	<p>the report.</p>
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		<p>and residents who were present between 11.AM and 11.15 AM but not been counted by the assessors are forwarded herewith (Annexure 1). Had the above mentioned faculties and residents were counted on their presentation with the reasonable time of the arrival of the assessors, there would not have been any faculty/residents deficiency at all. A wave of mass protest was there across the state against the brutal murder of a Dalit Law student at Ernakulam District in Kerala. As part of social commitment our resident doctors and house surgeons had planned a special protest in the Calicut city demanding CBI probe in to the incident. It was also one of the reason .This was the reason why many resident doctors were not available at the time of the assessors reached the college, but they turned up within one hour of the information about the inspection. Photographs showing the protest march of our resident doctors and house surgeons are attached herewith. Copies of certain media reports showing the gravity of the incident is also enclosed herewith. Copies of certain news item appeared in National English Dailies are enclosed herewith for your kind reference (Annexure III). The minor deficiency in the inpatient strength in the morning hours on the day of inspection was due to the indefinite strike and non cooperation by the Nurses in the hospital. There was an acute drought and the temperature was most alarming in our district and several deaths were happened everyday due to sunstroke for the last fortnight and due to this District Collector had announced holidays for all the educational institutions in the districts which has also affected our patient's strength. We had also announced holidays for the college in this weeks due to the high temperature and shortage of water.</p>

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
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

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

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(A) For Teaching Faculty:

- (b) Any excess teaching faculty in higher cadre can compensate the deficiency of lower cadre of the same department only.
- (c) Any excess teaching faculty of lower cadre/ category in any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in the higher cadre/ category of the same department or any other department. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of Associate Professor or Professor.
- (d) Excess/Extra teaching faculty of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in any other department.

(B) For Resident Doctors:

- (a) Excess of SR can be compensated to the deficiency of JR of the same department only.
- (b) Excess SR/JR of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR in any other department.
- (c) Any excess of JR cannot compensate the deficiency of SR in same or any other department.
- (d) Any excess/ extra teaching faculty of same or any other department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of SR or JR.

(2) A separate department of Dentistry/Dental faculty is not required where a dental college is available in same campus/city and run by the same management.

(3) Colleges running PG program require additional staff, beds & other requirements as per the PG Regulations - 2000.
