- (d) Any excess/ extra teaching faculty of same or any other department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/IR. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of SR or JR.
- (2) A separate department of Dentistry/Dental faculty is not required where a dental college is available in same campus/city and run by the same management.
- (3) Colleges running PG program require additional staff, beds & other requirements as per the PG Regulations 2000.



These plans are being submitted to Building proposal section of MCGM and is under process. Budget for the said project has been allocated in the financial year 2017-18. The said 'L' shaped building is expected to be completed with five years. Copy of the L shaped building plans is enclosed herewith.

- 6. Form 'A' is also not available

- 8. Bed Occupancy slightly inadequate (74.12% available as against the requirement of 75%).
- 9. In Clinical Material: No mention of Minor OT

Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at T.N.Medical College, Mumbai.

Ref: your letter dated 11th June 2013 No.MCI:34(41)(UG)/2012-MAH/12539.

Sir.

We are in receipt of your above mentioned letter in which Board of Governors have listed point wise deficiencies after consideration of the assessment report submitted by council assessors after assessment of physical and teaching facilities carried out by the assessors on 12th and 13th July 2012.

In view of these deficiencies you have requested us to submit the undertaking from the State Chief Secretary indicating budgetary proof of the funds allocated for rectifying the deficiencies. We would to like clarify that our institute is governed by and is under the administrative control of Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (MCGM) and not under Government of Maharashtra. All budgetary provisions are made by MCGM

Further many of the deficiencies listed in your letter are not appropriate and/or misinterpreted and hence we would like to clarify on these deficiencies point wise as under

Sr. No. 1. Although total faculty is adequate, however, department wise shortage is as under:

- Anatomy 4 tutors (p.39)

- Community Medicine - Assistant Professor cum epidemiologist-1

- Assistant Professor cum statistician - 1 (page 40)

Clarification:



- Anatomy department has 15 Junior Residents who are MBBS doctors registered for MD (Anatomy) course. These Junior Resident doctors are considered and counted as Tutors. This information has been submitted to the council assessors at the time of assessment
- Department of Community Medicine has 2 Professor (1 extra), 4 Associate Professor (2 excess) and 6 Assistant Professors at the time of inspection. The deficiency of Epidemiologist and a Statistician can be adjusted by considering the excess staff in the department. These 2 excess Associate Professor and 1 excess Asst. Professor should be adjusted against the requirement of 1 Epidemiologist and 1 Statistician. Dr Bandi (Asst Professor is considered as Epidemiologist and Mr Jain is working in the capacity of a Statistician.

Sr No. 2: Resident Shortage by 42.9% (p.42)

Clarification: The posts of Senior Resident Doctors are advertised regularly. Some of the posts get filled, but many of these doctors resign from the posts after some time. Although the numbers of senior resident doctors' posts were vacant on the given day, the college now has appointed 34 senior resident doctors for a total of 72 posts of senior residents. It may be noted that the clinical and teaching activities are carried out with the help of Junior Resident Doctors and Asst. Professors; who are on duty round the clock by rotation

Sr No. 3: Shortage of one Lecture Theatre of 250 capacity

Clarification: The College admits 120 students every year for the MBBS Course. As per Schedule I and A.1.5 of the MCI requirements for 150 admissions, "Lecture Theaters: There shall be a minimum of five lecture theatres preferably air-conditioned, of gallery type in the institution out of which four will be of seating capacity for 180 students and one will be of capacity for 350 students.

It may be noted that the College has three lecture halfs of the capacity of 160 students each and seven lecture theatres of the capacity of 60 students each. In addition, a big lecture theatre having a capacity of 180 is planned and the work would commence soon.

An Examination Hall with a seating capacity for 300 is proposed in the new OPD building and the work would be commenced soon.

Sr. No.4: Seating Capacity in the Examination cum Auditorium is less by 70

Clarification: The College has a well-equipped Auditorium. You are requested to refer to page 5 of the Assessors report and capacity is adequate.

Sr No.5: Information regarding Library, Residential Quarters for teaching and non teaching staff, casualty beds, RHTC and UHTC are not available.

Our clarification: Kindly note that these details were provided

[1] Library facilities: Detailed information about Library facilities was provided to the Assessors and this information has been mentioned on page 6 of their report under section 1.11 Library

- [2] Residential Quarters for the Teaching and non-teaching staff: The information regarding the residential quarters for teaching and non-teaching staff at various locations within campus and also outside campus at Mahalaxmi, Worli and Haji Ali was provided to the Assessors.
- [3] Casualty: Information about casualty services was provided to the Assessors and they have included it in the Assessors' Report (Page 15 section 2.9). The provision for Casualty services and Casualty beds is adequate.
- [4] Information about RHTC and UHTC has been provided in Form A (Page 21 and 23). The College has 3 RHTC which are located at Parol, Bhatane and Ganeshpuri. The College also has 2 UHTCs. These are located at Shivaji Nagar, Govandi and Cheetah Camp, Trombay.

Sr No. 6: Form A is not available

Clarification: The College had provided three copies of the Form A (duly filled in) to the Assessors at the time of assessment in separate files. In addition, one copy was sent to your office. A photocopy of the Form A submitted earlier, is enclosed

Sr No. 7: Inadequate Interns hostel (72 available as against requirement of 100%)

Clarification: Details about hostel facilities has been mentioned on p.7 and are adequate

Sr No. 8: Bed occupancy slightly inadequate (74.12% available as against the requirement of 75%)

Clarification: : BYL Nair Charitable Hospital, attached to the TN Medical College has a capacity of 1122 beds and the average bed occupancy is 69.5%. This translates into 780 beds being occupied on a day (as an average). As per the MCI requirement for 150 students the number of beds required is 700 (Refer Section B.1.18 and B.1.19 of the Schedule I). Therefore there is no deficiency in the number of beds or in bed occupancy for 120 admissions to our institute

Sr No. 9: In clinical material: No mention of Minor OT

Clarification: The details regarding Minor Operation Theatre (Minor OT) have been included in the Assessors' Report (Page 16).

Sr No. 10: Facilities in Anatomy Lab such as Embalming machine, MRICT, Bandsaw not available as per assessor's report

Clarification: The department of Anatomy has a Embalming machine which is operated by foot pump. There are 15 specimens of MRICT in the anatomy lab. A bandsaw machine is available for cutting the dead bodies.

Sr No. 11: Clinical Pharmacology, Pharmacy and Pathology facilities are inadequate

Clarification: This is not based on the facts. The Department of Pharmacology has well equipped Pharmacy, Experimental and Research Laboratories. These laboratories are equipped with working instruments such as Electroconvulsiometer, Photoactometer, Cooke's Pole Climbing apparatus, Hot plate, Sherrington Drum etc. Research work (including research for Dissertations) is carried out in these laboratories.

Kindly note that Pathology facilities are also mentioned as 'adequate" in the assessor's report (Page no. 34)

We would like you to consider that our institute is an old public charitable institute and is under administrative control of MCGM.

I request you to take the note of the above clarifications and consider our institute for the continuation of recognition of MBBS degree granted by MUHS, Nashik in respect of admission of 120 students being trained at our institute.
