



We, the final year students of Karpagam Faculty of Medical Sciences and Research, Colmbatore, Tamilnadu wish to again bring to your notice the problems faced by the medical students of this college.

We had written to you earlier about the management's temporary arrangements for the inspection by the Medical Council of India. We had requested you to look into the exorbitant fess more than the Government approved fees collected in this college. Still the situation has not changed. For the Final Year MBBS Examinations, the management had made arrangements to bring few patients from other hospitals till the MCI inspectors visit which was on the second day of the examinations.

Recently, the Medical Record Office person was dismissed as he did not obey to create false records.

There are very few **deliveries** happening in this hospital, which can be verified from the birth intimations officially sent to the Registration department.

The surgeries are also falsely written as though many surgeries are done daily.

Out patients are brought from the neighbouring places after 10 a.m on the inspection days.

The **Inpatients** are also not genuine and persons from the old age homes, mental asylums and building workers are posed as patients.

The sanitation inside the hospital and hostels are very poor. We are not provided with places to study inside the hostels, like the colleges in other places.

There are three high tension power lines travelling through the college and hostels which are ignored by the inspectors obviously for the material benefits obtained from the management.

We request you to send honest, trustworthy and sincere inspectors for the MCI Inspection which is to happen in this year.

In pursuance of the said complaint, all the 3 assessors joined interacted with 2 batches of students separately (1st year and Final year MBBS students), and the Dean of the college the following were observations:

1. Fees collected by the College: Students told that the students admitted under Government quota through state counselling, the fees charged were Rs. 4, 00,000 per annum and an additional Rs. 1, 10,000 was collected from those staying in the hostel. Regarding those students admitted under Management quota, the fees collected were Rs.5, 00,000 per annum and Rs.1, 10,000 for hostel. Also this being a Telegu minority college, admissions is 50% each for both the categories (Proof of minority status is being attached)

However as per statement given by the Dean only Rs.3, 55,000 are being collected by the college.

- 2. **Deliveries in the hospital**: On the day of inspection there was 2 deliveries by C- section. On an average 1 delivery per day is recorded as per the register. On our request to provide us the data sent to Government for registration of births, nothing was provided in spite of repeated requests.
- 3. Regarding high tension power lines: It is true the high tension line is passing through the campus.
- 4. Surgeries: On the day of inspection, 12 major and 8 minor surgeries were noted by us.
- 5. **Sanitation in the hospital**: Overall was fine but in certain wards and corridors, sanitation needs to be improved.
- 6. Regarding patients we have given actual statitistics of patients present in the various wards.
- 7. Other issues raised could not be verified
