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



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1 hour. Those who have reached to sign the attendance sheets a few minutes later were also not considered and their declaration forms were not checked.

- The Assessor who visited the Operation Theatres did not note down the names of two Faculty of Orthopaedics, Dr. Anjani Kumar, Associate Professor of Orthopaedics and Dr. Siva Kesavulu, Assistant Professor of Orthopaedics even though their names were intimated by the OT Nurse and their declaration forms were not checked leading to a deficiency of 6.82% i.e. 9/132. Dr. Anjani Kumar is working at Malla Reddy Medical College for Women since 01.06.2017 and Dr. Siva Kesavulu is working since 01.03.2016 and their Bank Statements are enclosed. If those 02 Faculties were considered, the deficiency of Faculty would have been 7/132 i.e. around 5%.
