Notes:

For purpose of working out the deficiency:

(1) The deficiency of teaching faculty and Resident Doctors shall be counted separately.

(A) For Teaching Faculty:

- (a) For calculating the deficiency of faculty, Prof., Assoc Prof., Asst. Prof & Tutor in respective departments shall be counted together.
- (b) Any excess teaching faculty in higher cadre can compensate the deficiency of lower cadre of the same department only.
- (c) Any excess teaching faculty of lower cadre/ category in any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in the higher cadre/category of the same department or any other department. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of Associate Professor or Professor.
- (d) Excess/Extra teaching faculty of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in any other department.

(B) For Resident Doctors:

- (a) Excess of SR can be compensated to the deficiency of JR of the same department only.
- (b) Excess SR/JR of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR in any other department.
- (c) Any excess of JR cannot compensate the deficiency of SR in same or any other department.
- (d) Any excess/ extra teaching faculty of same or any other department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR.
- e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of SR or JR.
- (2) A separate department of Dentistry/Dental faculty is not required where a dental college is available in same campus/city and run by the same management.

(3) Colleges running PG program require additional staff, beds & other requirements as per the PG Regulations - 2000.

In the first inspection on 16^{th} & 17^{th} November 2015, the assessors have noted deficiency of teaching faculty as **1.84%**, below 2%. No other deficiency was pointed out, either in residents or clinical material or infrastructure or other facilities.

Second surprise inspection was carried out on 4th December, 2015, again to verify clinical material, faculty and residents. Increase of additional 50 seats was not permitted, citing deficiency of faculty and clinical material.

A compliance report was submitted to the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and MCI, clarifying the reasons for the deficiencies pointed out by the assessors, as under.

The faculty deficiency during the inspection day on 04/12/2015 was because of the following reasons.

During the year 2015, there were (19) MCI inspections, either for PG recognition or increase of PG seats or UG admissions since May 2015. The management did not permit the faculty or residents to avail any kind of leave from May' 2015 till the last inspection i.e. 17th November 2015. Since the inspection was over successfully, the management has permitted the staff to avail their accumulated leaves and carrying out major camps were deferred till January 2016, as the faculty were permitted to avail leave.

The hospital is conducting one major health camp every week and 1-2 specialty camps in between during each week in the surrounding Rural areas. Through these camps the hospital is getting regular patient flow and it is benefiting the nearby villages to get the health care at their door steps. (Copy of Health Camps conducted is enclosed) Annexure-I

Patients admitted in wards, who were referred for Radiological investigations, like USG, MRI, CT, X-Ray etc., Pre-anaesthetic check up or referred to other departments, were not counted. More than 30 in patients were discharged and they were not available on the beds.

There are 45 beds in acute care areas where about 26 In-patients were under treatment, who were not counted. They are either shifted from in patient wards or admitted directly for intensive care treatment. Had they also were counted; % of occupancy would have gone up more than 70%. Unfortunately, the assessors did not check the in-patient register or the computer records in the reception counter.

For unknown reasons, the Assessor did not take into account all the above patients on that particular day of Assessment. In fact, on an average the bed occupancy is 75% to 80% every day, if it is calculated per annum. As per Minimum Standard Requirements for Medical College Regulations, 1999 (Amended up to July 2015), under Clause B.1.8, the minimum requirement of Bed occupancy shall be 75% per Annum, as per the terms of Notification published on 03/11/2009 in the Gazette of India. During earlier inspections the assessors used to check the clinical material randomly, i.e., average patients on any particular day of the previous three to four months. (Copies of Clinical Material pertaining to IP for the months of March, April & May 2016 are enclosed) Annexure-III Deficiency is clarified.

For purpose of working out the deficiency:

(1) The deficiency of teaching faculty and Resident Doctors shall be counted separately.

(A) For Teaching Faculty:

- (a) For calculating the deficiency of faculty, Prof., Assoc Prof., Asst. Prof & Tutor in respective departments shall be counted together.
- (b) Any excess teaching faculty in higher cadre can compensate the deficiency of lower cadre of the same department only.
- (c) Any excess teaching faculty of lower cadre/ category in any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in the higher cadre/category of the same department or any other department. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of Associate Professor or Professor.
- (d) Excess/Extra teaching faculty of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in any other department.

(B) For Resident Doctors:

- (a) Excess of SR can be compensated to the deficiency of JR of the same department only.
- (b) Excess SR/JR of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR in any other department.
- (c) Any excess of JR cannot compensate the deficiency of SR in same or any other department.
- (d) Any excess/ extra teaching faculty of same or any other department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/IR.
