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been counted by the Inspectors for the reasons that they may not be significant for the purpose of teaching. The finding of the Inspectors is not that these were fake admissions, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of MCI also stated that admissions of these patients have not been doubted but they have been excluded on the ground of not useful for the purpose of teaching. In our opinion, these patients have to be counted towards bed occupancy. It is not the requirement that admitted patients should be useful for teaching purpose, only then they can be counted for bed occupancy. When these nine patients are counted, admittedly, in that case the requisite percentage of bed occupancy is made out..."

Most of the Patients in the Department of Orthopaedics have not been counted for the reason that they are admitted for OA (Osteo Arthritis) & Low backache, in the Department of General Medicine for OA (Osteo Arthritis), in the Department of ENT for CSOM (Chronic Suppurative Otitis Media), in the Department of Skin & VD and Department of Paediatrics for General Pruritus and in the Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology for Discharge PV and chronic pain Abdomen.

Some of the patients were not counted by the Assessors of the MCI as they were not present in their Wards and had gone for Physiotherapy sessions, Ultrasound, X-ray etc. Copy of Department wise IPD Data of the Medical College on the day of Assessment i.e. 07.01.2019 is annexed herewith and marked as **Annexure-8**. That for the UG courses (MBBS), there was no upper age limit restriction for appointment of Senior Residents in the Medical College and as per the Amendment Notification which came into effect from 5th June, 2017, the requirement of 40 years of age is applicable in the Broad Speciality courses (MD/ MS) for the teaching purpose/PG guide mentioned as under"

- (c) Any excess of JR cannot compensate the deficiency of SR in same or any other department.
- (d) Any excess/ extra teaching faculty of same or any other department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of SR or JR.
- (2) A separate department of Dentistry/Dental faculty is not required where a dental college is available in same campus/city and run by the same management.
- (3) Colleges running PG program require additional staff, beds & other requirements as per the PG Regulations 2000.
