(4) IN ENT wards patients with trivial complaints like earache and uncomplicated CSOM and vertigo have been admitted for more than 1 week.

In gynaec ward most of case sheets have been written as being admitted with either threatened abortion, irregular menses or PID but on verification no such symptoms were mentioned by the patients, and the patients were asymptomatic.

In certain wards like ENT and Gynecology patients were allowed to go on leave thereby suggesting that patients were coming in the morning and going home in evening(copies of case sheets attached(5).

- (2) A separate department of Dentistry/Dental faculty is not required where a dental college is available in same campus/city and run by the same management.
- (3) Colleges running PG program require additional staff, beds & other requirements as per the PG Regulations 2000.

## 8. 1) Deficiency of Teaching Faculty: 5.38 % (7 out of 130)

### 2) Deficiency of Resident doctors: 19.4% (13 out of 67)

Deficiency of residents was observed to be 2.98% (computed out of 67 residents) but on verification of Senior residents Hostels it was found that about 50% of SRs were not residing in the Hostel. (videographic evidence enclosed).

The Assessors waited in the residents hostels for more than one and half Hour for residents to come and show their rooms.

They were repeatedly called by the respective wardens. However most of the SRs did not come.

Some, who came (names mentioned below) were found not to be residing in Hostel as evidenced by videographic evidence of no

clothes in cupboards, no toiletries in bathroom, no lights in rooms, unusable toilets etc.( enclosed).

Complaint against Authorities and Management of Subharti

Medical College, Meerut.

Madam,

We conducted an Assessment at Subharti Medical College, Meerut on 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> October 2017 for recognition of Increase of Seats from 100 to 150(vide.Ref No.MCI-37(1)/UG/2018-19-MED/dated11.10.2017).Certain irregularities and improper conduct of the authorities and management was noted by us and we would like to bring to your notice.

We reached the college at 9:30am; the Dean was not in office. He came after 10 minutes. We informed him of the procedure to be observed regarding attendance of faculty, bed occupancy and OPD assessment. By 11.15 am attendance was completed .Attendance of all residents and faculty of all departments was noted on attendance sheet. The Dean was informed repeatedly regarding the 11am cut off as per Assessor's guide. At 11:10AM a Senior Faculty himself locked the door and all Faculty and Residents present in the Lecture Theatre were called over to complete the process.

One Assessor took rounds of Medicine and Allied departments. There were young boys who said they were brought in from a Madarssa in the morning. Out of 10 boys (purportedly IPD patients), only 2 boys had their names written on the case papers, without any clinical notes on it, while rest of the boys had no case papers. The boys looked healthy not requiring admission and hence we are of the view that they were not genuine patients. Further, these papers with no clinical notes were taken by us for photocopying and were kept with the knowledge of Dean in Dean's office. However, in the evening these blank admission sheets disappeared from the Dean's office and on enquiry he feigned

ignorance and displayed helplessness in getting the papers retrieved. We requested him to get the CCTV footage checked. This request was also declined. We told him that the loss of such papers was a serious issue and the College should lodge complaint for loss of records to the Police.

We completed the assessment on the first day by 8:30 PM and when we were going back to our Hotel certain people were using abusive language against us behind our back. Such behavior was totally uncalled for.

However, in the morning Dr. Mukti Bhatnagar stood with folded hands at the gate as we entered and said she took the afore-mentioned case papers and had left. She could give no satisfactory reason for doing so. As the papers could have anything written on them overnight, we did not ask for them in the morning.

While doing faculty and resident verification it came to our notice that all appointments were done by Subharati University but salaries were paid by a Trust and joining given by Dean. Noticing these discrepancies, we asked the Dean for clarification and also contacted MCI office. A Mr. Atul who identified himself as Advisor to VC came in and said that the authorities were refusing the inspection and would give us a letter to that effect. Meanwhile, around 50 to 100 people entered the hall and were arguing with us loudly and in aggressive tone. One of these persons, was very rude and aggressive, and on asking he said that he was Professor of Opthalmology. We also contacted the travel agent to change our booking but the letter given to us did not mention refusal of assessment. They were constantly haranguing us to call up MCI for further clarification, respond to the letter by another letter of our own and also making wild allegations against us and MCI. Following due procedure as no written refusal had gone through we carried on with the assessment. As role of Subharti University in appointment was unclear, the faculty and residents appointed by Subharti University was not accepted by us. The authorities said they had documents which prove that University could appoint faculty but they refused to give them to us saying, let MCI reject, call them only then we will give you the papers. They were explained that Assessors merely put in their observations and decision was taken by EC.

We also noted repeated discussions regarding MCI and statements like they (Subharti college) are the best college and yet MCI is against them . They named certain individuals who were unknown to us by name or by face , as enemies of Subharti University and said these aforementioned people, are people from the MCI and we are the agents of these enemies of Subharti college. They also said that these people are using assessors against the college and then they will abandon us, so we should contact the MCI for our own safety. They also boasted of connections with Union Ministers and Bureaucrats. Also senior faculty repeatedly told us that Mr. Atul likes fighting with MCI and Dr. Mukti wants compromise but that is not working out; trying to create the impression that this official Government work was more of a personalized agenda, which gave rise to our suspicions regarding their motives. They also enquire regarding Dr. Vimala Thomas who they said has never been an Assessor at their college, so they seem to have done some background assessment of assessors rather than facing an assessment with Honesty and clarity.

We also noted that during these two days a lot of people seem to be recording us on their cell-phones and possibility of doctoring of videos arises in our minds. A particular statement needs to be brought on record here made by one Mr. Atul "You are agents of MCI take the key of our college and lock it up and close it because that is what MCI wants. Why are you doing an assessment." Such kind of statements shows lack of cooperation from the College Authorities and are made with the objective of derailing the assessment process.

We also wish to say that despite many provocations ,we maintained our composure and did not react to such provocations & conducted the assessment as per the assessors guide .



Madam,

It is to put on record that today at about 9.30 am, the team of Assessors appointed by the MCI, visited our institution for surprise inspection, the coordinator of which was Dr. Pallavi Saple.

Right from the very beginning, when they started conducting the inspection, they had been behaving abnormally with the faculty and the officers of the College for no rhyme or reason. The other lady member of the team locked the doors of the Lecture Theater exactly at 11.00 am, where the faculty and the residents were asked to collect for attendance. Those faculty members/residents who were on night duty or were attending any serious patient and came even after one minute, were not allowed to enter and sign the attendance sheet.

At one point of time, the coordinator herself suggested to one of our senior faculty members that "when you have such a good infrastructure and everything, then why you people do not keep good relations with the MCI". Considering that none of our faculty members had said that we had any strained relations with MCI, her comments clearly show that some officer of the MCI has said something to her because of which she reached to the conclusion that MCI is annoyed with us. If it is so, the reasons may kindly be told to us so that we may try to remove them.

In the afternoon, the coordinator raised an issue that she was not going to accept any faculty members or the residents because their appointment letters were issued by the Registrar of the University and not by the Principal of the College. The Advisor to the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of the University, of which the Subharti Medical College is a constituent College, was called to explain the system of appointment followed in the University. She told him that the question was not raised by her but she had been instructed to do so by the MCI. I gave her a letter to confirm her statement that she was raising such an issue on the instructions of the MCI but she refused to accept the letter. A copy of the letter is Annexure No. 1.

She grossly misbehaved with the senior faculty members of the College like with Dr. K.P.S. Malik, Professor & Head, Dept. of Ophthalmology. It is to mention that Dr. K.P.S. Malik is a very senior Professor and a person of National Repute. His only mistake was that he tried to convince the Assessors that it was not written anywhere in the MCI norms that the letter of appointment should be signed by the Principal and not by the Registrar of the University. He also requested the Coordinator to let him know where in the norms of the MCI, it was written that the appointment letters should only be signed by the Principal of the College.

She misbehaved with many other faculty members also. Many faculty members were also not accepted by her on the basis of non-existing and baseless reasons. This was in addition to the issue of the appointment letter being issued by the Registrar. She said to her lady colleague in front of one of our senior faculty members that the MCI un-necessarily made us raise the issue of the appointment letters, because I could have easily rejected the college raising many questions related to the clinical material.

At about 9.00 pm, she demanded some patient files from the undersigned. I was totally unaware of those files. She told me that she had picked up some patient files while taking the round of the hospital in the morning and had kept them in my office without telling me about the patient files. I tried to find out the files but those were not present in my room. I asked her to let me know the names of the patients of whom the files belonged or to visit the concerned wards again. I told her that it was possible that the patient files might have been taken away by the staff to give treatment to patients. But, she was not prepaid for anything except shouting and threatening that she would file F.I.R.

I, most respectfully submit that as per the Assessors Guide of the MCI, the assessment should be done in such a way that the routine of the hospital is not disturbed. If she had brought the files of some patients from the wards, it was against the norms of the Assessors Guide because that must have caused hindrance in the treatment of patients and which, as a matter of fact was a criminal act. She could have taken snaps in her mobile from the files or could have asked someone to get the files photocopied, if she had found anything objectionable in the patient files.

We have been co-operating with the team of Assessors with utmost cordiality and to our level best. Before leaving the College today about 9.30 pm, she mentioned that we should write our objections to the inspection report, because by that time we must have come to know what the report would be. Her comments have made us apprehensive that justice may not be given to us by the team of Assessors, if their attitude remains the same. I request you to kindly direct the Coordinator of the team to follow the norms laid down by the MCI in the Assessors Guide.
