Hence, these 42 patients were not considered while calculating the final bed occupancy. Thus, our actual bed occupancy is 207 out of 300 i.e. 69%.

Explanation regarding the 10 (ten) Patients which were not considered by the Assessors alleging that they did not require admission:

All these patients were having multiple symptoms. They were admitted as per the chief complaints. Other departmental referrals were also done. All of them were admitted only after proper observation, scrutiny & appropriate diagnosis by concerned experienced faculty members. Medicine ward was inspected by the designated
